In a recent field and school monitoring at Barangay Magnao in Tabuk City in Kalinga, the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) Strand witnessed the ingenious and effective use of walkie-talkies or handheld radios for DepEd blended learning. With no internet signal and affected by the recent typhoons, walkie-talkies (2-way radios) are being used for learning and teaching at Magnao Elementary School by 154 students and 7 teachers.
