Rationale and General Description of the Activity:

This 2022, U.P. Lipunang Pangkasaysayan is holding its 31st National Conference of History Students. Throughout the years, the Committee on Education and Research has continually made the event an achievement and served as a venue for all undergraduate history students from all over the country to gather.

The 30th National Conference will be held with the theme ***Banwá'an: Urbanismo at Kasaysayang Pilipino.*** (*Banwá'an: Urbanism and Philippine History*)

Due to the safety protocols being implemented, it will be held online, through our event's official Facebook page, on October 22, 29 and November 5, 2022. Everyone is encouraged and invited to witness this event.

The theme will aim to provide insight and understanding to the current economic struggles faced by the Philippines, as well as the development of the livelihood of the Filipinos as the building factor of the country's economy through the years.
