NATIONAL COMMISSION OF SENIOR CITIZENS (NCSC) CELEBRATION OF ELDERLY FILIPINO WEEK

The National Commission of Senior Citizens (NCSC) in collaboration with the Department of Education (DepEd)- Region XII promotes mutual respect, understanding and better connection between the schoolchildren and the Filipino elderly to strengthen relations for value formation and nation-building.

In line with this, NCSC enjoins every division and schools in the region to celebrate **Elderly Filipino Week** through simple yet impactful classroom activities. This is commemorated every October 1-7 by virtue of Proclamation No. 470.

Classroom teachers may design activities like making tribute cards and/or inviting grandparents to be involved in school related activities like storytelling and sharing experiences that would enrich learning among the schoolchildren. Also, teachers are encouraged to provide space for deeper and meaningful intergenerational conversations between the youths and the older generations during the celebration of the Elderly Filipino Week.

Pursuant to DO 34, s. 2022, all participating private and public schools shall observe strict compliance to dedicating school days to academics and co-curricular activities, hence, planned classroom activities shall be integrated to related subjects to highlight this significant celebration.
