REGION MEMORANDUM CLMD No. 317, s. 2022

REGIONAL ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODE (ADM) PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW (PIR)

To: All Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. With reference to the Learning Recovery and Continuity Plan towards the Better Normal and the *Alternaturo Program* of the Department of Education SOCCSKSARGEN Region, this region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will conduct the Regional Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) Program Implementation Review (PIR)) on **October 28, 2022**, in a venue to be announced later in a separate issuance.
- 2. The said activity aims to:
 - a. Gain insights on how the ADM is implemented in the schools division offices (SDOs) and schools;
 - b. Reflect on how ADM contributes to quality, inclusive, relevant, and liberating education for all types of learners who are in emergencies and difficult circumstances:
 - c. Elicit the highlights, challenges, and initiatives encountered by the schools in the implementation of the ADM in preparation for the crafting of the contextualized policy; and
 - d. Provide technical assistance in the implementing schools to improve the implementation of the ADM.
- 3. The participants for the said activity are the division ADM coordinators.
- 4. All participants are enjoined to prepare a 15-minute PowerPoint presentation (ppt) regarding the implementation of the ADM following the enclosed template (Enclosure No. 1).
- 5. Likewise, participants are requested to bring the following:
 - a. Laptop
 - b. Extension wire
 - c. Pocket WiFi, and
 - d. Vaccination card/certificate
- 6. Accommodation, board and lodging, and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the Region's MOOE (CLMD-GASS fund) while traveling expenses incurred during the activity shall be charged against local funds of the concerned office of the participants subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.



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- 7. Enclosed are the template of the presentation and indicative schedule of activities for guidance and reference.

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


