REGION MEMORANDUM CLMD No. 334 s. 2022

THIRD QUARTER MADRASAH EDUCATION PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW AND CATCH-UP PLANNING WORKSHOP

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. Relevant to the regional office program management roles and responsibilities as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 025, s. 2021, the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall spearhead the Third Quarter Madrasah Education Program Implementation Review (PIR) and Catch-up Planning Workshop on **November 2-4, 2022,** in General Santos City. Specific venue of the activity shall be announced through a separate region memorandum.
- 2. The workshop shall be conducted to:
 - a) review the implementation of SDO-led MEP projects and activities;
 - b) monitor the implementation of the SDO's MEP Work and Financial Plans;
 - c) discuss relevant program implementation issues and provide solutions to these issues; and
 - d) provide technical assistance to division coordinators in preparing catchup plan for implementation towards the end of CY 2022.
- 3. The participants to this activity are the CLMD Chief, Regional MEP/ALIVE Coordinator, Division ALIVE Coordinators and two (2) selected school heads from each SDO. The host SDO of General Santos City may identify additional participants as support staff and workshop documenters.
- 4. All Division ALIVE Coordinators are enjoined to prepare 10-minute presentation covering the following:
 - a) Report on the Utilization of MEP Funds allotted for ALIVE teachers' salary, IMs allowance including PSF for CY 2022;
 - b) Implementation Updates Work and Financial Plan (WFP) for CY 2022;
 - c) Progress M&E Report on Tagging of ALIVE learners to LIS for SY 2022-2023; and
 - d) Program implementation issues/challenges and proposed solutions.
- 5. Food, accommodation, and workshop kits of participants shall be taken care of by the host SDO and these shall be charged to the division Madrasah Education Program Support Funds. The travel expenses of participants shall be charged to their



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respective division MEP PSF or local funds subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
