To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. The Bureau of Learning Delivery-Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD) shall conduct a **training-workshop to upskill school leaders and expand their capabilities in managing the last mile multigrade schools**, Batch 3, on **October 10-15, 2022 at Apo View Hotel, J. Camus St., Davao City**.

This training supports the Basic Education Development Plan 2030 (BEDP 2030) in addressing the immediate impact of the pandemic on learning, participation, and education delivery in the multigrade context.
