REGION MEMORANDUM CLMD No. 370, s. 2022

PARTICIPANTS TO THE NATIONAL TRAINING OF ALS TEACHERS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CONTEXTUALIZED MELCs-BASED ALS-SHS CURRICULUM MINDANAO CLUSTER

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. With reference to OM-OAGA-2022-00129 titled National Training of ALS Teachers on the Implementation of the Contextualized Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) -Based Alternative Learning System Senior High School (ALS SHS) Curriculum – Mindanao Cluster, the Department of Education through the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) will conduct the said activity at Swiss -Belhotel Blulane, 609 Tomas Mapua Street, Sta. Cruz, Manila, National Capital Region on November 7-12, 2022.

- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a. Develop a deep understanding, familiarization, and appreciation of the Contextualized MELCs-based ALS SHS Curriculum among ALS Teachers;
 - b. Train the ALS Teachers of pilot schools on the delivery and contextualization process of learning competencies in the ALS context; and
 - c. Enable the teacher-participants to prepare an implementation plan of the Contextualized MELCs-based ALS SHS Curriculum in their respective school.

3. Participants in the said training are select ALS SHS teachers listed in the enclosure.

4. Identified participants are required to bring their own laptops and a copy of the MELCs of their assigned core or applied subjects during the training.

5 All concerned are also requested to comply with all COVID-19 Alert Level System protocols set by the national and local Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging and Infectious Diseases (IATF), as well as the most recent DepEd rules and/or policies.

6. The concerned school heads of the identified participants are directed to strictly institute measures and procedures to ensure that there will be no disruption of classes during the duration of the training. (Refer to DO 9, s. 2005, DO 44, s. 2022 and RM CLMD 337, s. 2022)







7. Transportation expenses, board and lodging, other expenses for supplies and materials, and other incidental expenses incurred for this activity shall be charged against the 2022 FLO-ALS Continuing Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants will be downloaded directly to respective Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and shall be paid in full upon submission of the required travel documents, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

8. In case the downloaded funds are not sufficient to cover the actual expenses incurred, the downloaded Program Support Fund (PSF) CY 2022 and local funds shall be utilized to augment the reimbursement of the said expenses.

9. Likewise attached are OM-OAGA-2022-00129, Advisory dated October 21, 2022, and Justifications signed by Marilette R. Alamayda, OIC – Director IV, Bureau of Alternative Education.

10. Teaching and non-teaching personnel attending the said activity shall be entitled to service credits pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, 2003 titled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Service Credit of Teachers and Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per CSC -DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 titled Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services, whichever is appropriate and applicable.
