## CALL FOR MASHAV SCHOLARSHIP - EDUCATORS PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT IN-SERVICE TRAINING

MASHAV – Israel's Agency for International Development Cooperation and MASHAV Educational Training Center (METC) is inviting professionals to participate in the Educators Professional Development In-Service Training on February 19, 2023 to March 8, 2023, to be held at METC-MASHAV Educational International Training Center, Ramat Rachel Hotel, Jerusalem, Israel. The accommodation will consist of double rooms with two participants per room.

This program is designed for policymakers and practitioners, such as Directors in the Education Department of Ministries of Education and local authorities, Educational Trainers, Principals of primary and secondary schools, Coordinators in primary and high schools, and Lecturers in Teacher Educational Institutions.

This training aims the following:

- a. To provide new tools and knowledge on the implementation and development of educators' professional aspects
- b. To provide frameworks as an answer to the differences between the teaching staff, between the different professions and allow each teaching staff to choose the learning path that suits them
- c. To create tools for communication, collaboration, and teamwork
- d. To provide educational tools for quality innovative educational pedagogies
- e. To support the integration and the implementation of 21st-century education skills
- f. To present innovative teaching methods for specific subject matters (Science, language, etc.), as well as interdisciplinary subject areas, enabling participants to choose the methods and tools suitable to the needs of their environments.

MASHAV awards a limited number of scholarships. The scholarship covers the cost of the training program including lectures and a tour of holy sites and locations of general and historical interest, full board accommodation in double rooms, health insurance, and transfers to and from the airport. **Airfares and daily allowance are not included in the scholarship.** 

The arrival date is scheduled on February 19, 2023, while the Opening Date will be on February 20, 2023. The closing date is on March 7, 2023, and departure date is on March 8, 2023. Early arrivals/late departures must be arranged by the participants themselves, directly with the hotel/center, and must be paid for by the participant him/herself/
