To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. This has reference to Region Memorandum PPRD No. 2023-001 regarding "PPRD 2023 Research Agenda as Mechanism in the Development of Research-Enabled Innovations," wherein one of the research agenda to be undertaken for Quarter 2 of FY 2023 which has original title of **Common Issues, Innovations, and School-Based Interventions of Schools' LIS Coordinators on Data Management: Basis for the Development of Capability Enhancement Program**.

2. For alignment purposes, such research agendum is revised to: School LIS-BEIS Coordinator's Competence and Division Innovations on Data Management: Basis for Development of Intervention Mechanisms.

3. This research undertaking is in line with the Policy, Planning & Research Division (PPRD) Operational Manual (OM) 2022, particularly on Policy Development Process with focus on the sub-processes on: "Policy Implementation and Review," which is anchored on "One DepEd, One QMS" strategic direction of DepEd CO.

4. The focus of this initiative is to formulate a localized research-based intervention policy focused on the following guidelines of DepEd Central Office:

4.a DepEd Order No. 32, s. 2018: Policy Guidelines on the Collection of Data/Information Requirements for Beginning of School Year 2018-2019 in the Learner Information System (LIS) and Enhanced Basic Education Information System

4.b Memorandum dated June 6, 2019: ICTS-User Support Division Helpdesk Process.

5. Generally, this study aims to develop intervention mechanisms to further capacitate the schools' LIS-BEIS coordinators on efficient and effective data management of basic education inputs. Specifically, it aims to realize the following indicative research objectives:

5.a Determine the school's LIS-BEIS coordinators' competence and efficiency in managing LIS-BEIS issues and concerns in terms of processing the following service requests: Request Form (RF)01 – LRN Merging, Request Form (RF) 02 – LRN Reactivation, Request Form (RF) 03 – Enrolment with







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Data Issues, Request Form (RF) 04 – Unmerging of LRN, Request Form (RF) 05 – UAMS and/or Reopening and Closing of Schools, Request Form (RF) 06 – Merging of School ID, Request Form (RF) 07 – Reopening of School Enrolment and EOSY Finalization, Request Form (RF) 08 – Transfer Related Issues, Request Form (RF) 09 – Unenrollment of Learner, and Incident Report.

5.b Find out if there is significant difference in the level of competence and efficiency on data management among school's LIS/BEIS Coordinators in terms of type of school: Elementary, Secondary, and Integrated School.

5.c Identify facilitating and hindering factors that affect effective data management in the LIS/BEIS.

5.d Ascertain division innovations on data management as initiated by Division Planning Officers (DPOs) and coordinators vis-à-vis LIS/BEIS-related issues and concerns.

5.e Develop intervention mechanisms to further improve LIS/BEIS school coordinators' competence on data management, based on the results of the study.

6. To fully realize this worthwhile endeavor, innovative strategies were firmedup to ensure that the study would be undertaken within the target timelines and effective collaboration with education stakeholders would be maximized. See the following enclosures for your references:
