REGION MEMORANDUM FTAD-2023-003

CONDUCT OF DIVISION KUMUSTAHAN ON SCHOOL GOVERNANCE COUNCILS (SGC)

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. DepEd Order No. 26, s. 2022 otherwise known as Implementing Guidelines on the Establishment of School Governance Council (SGC) sets the standard processes and procedures for public elementary and secondary schools in establishing their respective SGC.
- 2. Using the SGC Functionality Assessment Tool, this office determined the functionality of SGC in secondary schools in the region and based on the latest report submitted by the Schools Division Offices (SDOs), only 4.9% (31 out of 632 secondary schools) have functional SGCs.
- 3. The data implies that the RO and SDOs shall provide necessary technical assistance to all established SGCs in the region. Thus, the RO shall conduct **Quarterly Kumustahan to SDOs starting March 2023**.
- 4. The activity aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - a. Document practices on how shared governance is taking place in schools;
 - b. Establish effective feedback mechanism with SGCs on matters relevant to school operations; and
 - c. Provide technical assistance in crafting the SGC Sustainability Plan

- 6. Though the Central Office (CO) piloted the SGC Functionality Assessment Tool to be accomplished by all secondary schools, all elementary schools are likewise encouraged to establish their own SGCs using the same assessment tool.
- 7. Expenses incurred in the conduct of the activity such as food, venue, transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures and regulations.
