### BARKADA KONTRA DROGA (BKD) PROGRAM CONDUCT OF ONLINE SONG WRITING, JINGLE, AND LOGO MAKING COMPETITION 2023

To: Public Schools District Supervisor/Principal-In-Charge Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads Division Federated BKD Officers and Teacher- Advisers Municipal Federated BKD Officers and Teacher- Advisers All Others Concerned

1. In reference to Presidential Proclamation No. 124 issued on November 26, 2001, titled **Declaring the 3rd Week of November of Every Year as Drug Abuse Prevention and Control (DAPC) Week** from November 12–18, 2023, all DepEd offices and schools are enjoined to get involved in its social media campaign to make people aware of the dangers posed by drug abuse. DepEd offices may also conceptualize creative activities for learners and their families utilizing online and other platforms that are accessible to learners who will be staying in their homes during the period of the campaign. The regional and schools division offices and schools are encouraged to conduct appropriate, relevant, and related activities in partnership with local government units (LGUs), non-government organizations (NGOs), and other stakeholders, taking into consideration compliance with the DEP's required health standards due to the current situation brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. This year's theme, "People First: Stop Stigma and Discrimination, Strengthen Prevention," emphasizes the importance of combating disinformation campaigns about illegal drugs that can harm the public. The theme is a vital call to action to mitigate the negative impact of false information, broaden the public's knowledge to make them less susceptible to the myths and inaccuracies surrounding illegal drugs, and intensify their resilience against the influence of drug use.

3. Anent this, SDSC LEARNER FORMATION shall conduct competitions in jingle making, songwriting, and BKD logo making. Submission of entries will be on

The winners shall be declared during the closing ceremony of Division Learners Convergence 2023 on **December 10, 2023**.

### **Contest Mechanics**

I. THEME: "People First: Stop Stigma and Discrimination, Strengthen Prevention"

### **II. CONTEST GUIDELINES for JINGLE-MAKING**

- 1. The contest is open to all High School students (Grades 7-12) from both public and private schools of the Schools Division Office of South Cotabato.
- 2. There shall be **ONE (1) official entry per municipality** for the Jingle-Making Contest.
- 3. The group must consist of a minimum of five (5) and a maximum of ten (10) members.
- 4. Jingles can either be in Filipino or English language.
- 5. The jingle must deliver a clear and positive message about being proactive in Barkada Kontra Droga (BKD).
- 6. Entries should be an original composition by the learners but can be under the guidance of the coach.
- 7. Any musical instrument can be used to accompany the composed song and lyrics.
- 8. Entries shall be performed by the learners enrolled at the participating school, but the required health protocols imposed during this time of pandemic MUST be observed at all times.
- 9. The time duration must not exceed five (5) minutes.
- 10.No other individuals, except the performers, shall be seen in the video recording.
- 11. The following format and requirements shall be strictly followed for each submitted entry:
  - a. Video entry must be shot horizontally (landscape mode) and must clearly cover the totality of the presentation.
  - b. The camera to be used in filming the performance must be steady. Participants are encouraged to use a tripod to make the camera stable.

c.No unnecessary or extraneous noises, comments, and effects must be heard from the video except from the

instrument that is necessary in the presentation.

d. Submitted video entry must be continuous and should not be edited (no splicing, stitching, or application of visual effects).









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e.Video resolution of the submitted entry must be 1080p (High definition or higher if possible).

f. Entries shall be submitted in a .mp4 format, and lyrics in pdf format on or before November 17, 2023, 12:00 am at SDSCDAPC 2023 Official Google Drive Link: <u>https://bit.ly/SDSCYFDAPC2023</u> save to your respective Municipality Folder with the file name: (Name of School: Name of Learner)

Creativity (use of structure, instruments & vocals)	20%

### I. THEME: "People First: Stop Stigma and Discrimination, Strengthen Prevention"

### **II. CONTEST GUIDELINES for SONGWRITING COMPOSITION**

- 1. Songwriting composition is the process of creating new music either instrumental or contemporary music with lyrics.
- 2. The contest is open to all incoming high school students (Grades 7-12) from both public and private high schools of the Schools Division Office of South Cotabato.
- 3. There shall be **ONE** (1) official entry per municipality for the songwriting composition.
- 4. Any instrument/accompaniment and backup singer maybe used during the performance.
- 5. The song can either be in Filipino or English language and must be sung by the composer or any representatives.
- 6. Entries should be an original composition by the learners but can be under the guidance of the coach.
- 7. The time duration must not exceed three minutes and thirty seconds (3:30).
- 8. No other individuals, except the performers/ accompaniment, shall be seen in the video recording.
- 9. The following format and requirements shall be strictly followed for each submitted entry:

a. Video entry must be shot horizontally (landscape mode) and must clearly cover the totality of the presentation.

b. The camera to be used in filming the performance must be steady. Participants are encouraged to use a tripod to make the camera stable.

c. No unnecessary or extraneous noises, comments, and effects must be heard from the video except from the instrument that is necessary in the presentation.

d. Submitted video entry must be continuous and should not be edited (no splicing, stitching, or application of visual effects).

e. Video resolution of the submitted entry must be 1080p (high definition or higher if possible).

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f. 

#### **II. CONTEST GUIDELINES for Logo Making Contest**

- 1. The contest is open to all High School students (Grades 7-12) from both public and private schools of the Schools Division of South Cotabato.
- 2. Submission of entry should be ONE (1) entry per municipality.
- 3. The logo should not carry the name of the artist.
- 4. The logo design shall include the name of **BARKADA KONTRA DROGA** and **SOUTH COTABATO-LEARNER FORMATION**, also the design must effectively portray the vision and goals of the program.
- 5. The design of the logo should follow the Barkada Kontra Droga (BKD) official colors (blue, red, yellow and black). However, artist may add other color/s to complement their design.

The logo design should be built around vision and goals of BKD

- 6. Entries should be in digital format:
  - (1.)JPEG, PNG, Adobe Illustrator compatible or Adobe Photoshop compatible, fit to vertical A4 size with minimum 300 dpi and
  - (2.)in its original raw file. The original raw file. The filename is your School Name and artwork title. Example:
