**PROGRESS MONITORING AND REPORTING ON SCHOOL GOVERNANCE
COUNCIL (SGC) FUNCTIONALITY**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. DepEd Order (DO) 26, s. 2022 or the Implementing Guidelines on the Establishment of School Governance Council (SGC) aims to recognize and strengthen the role of school stakeholders, alongside Local Government Units (LGUs) as partners in providing learners their developmental needs as well as ensure effective education service delivery.

2. To ensure that each organized SGC is aligned to DO 26, s. 2022 specifically on its primary functions as a structure for shared governance and feedback mechanisms, the SGC Functionality Assessment Tool was issued and rolled-out to all SDOs starting October 2022. These roll-out initiatives and provision of technical assistance by the SDOs were complimented by the Regional Office through the SGC Kumustahan starting March until December 2023. The Kumustahan also serves as an avenue where issues and concerns in the implementation of DO 26, s. 2022 were tackled and clarified.

3. Regional and SDOs efforts of providing technical assistance to schools on the organization of their respective SGCs gained positive impacts in the over-all operations and performance of every school. Thus, the DepEd Regional Office 12 through the Field Technical Assistance Division (FTAD) shall conduct constant progress check/monitoring of the SGC Functionality status using the Quick Count and SDOs Report No. 2 starting January 12, 2024. All SDOs are advised to verify and validate all the documents prior to the uploading to the google link. All uploaded documents or MOVs will no longer be retrieved or corrected after its submission.

4. Timeline of the SGC Functionality Progress Monitoring and Reporting are as follows:
