> ANTI-ONLINE SEXUAL ABUSE AND EXPLOITATION OF CHILDREN (OSAEC) AND ANTI-CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE OR EXPLOITATION MATERIALS (CSAEM) CLASSROOM BASED SESSION DURING THE CELEBRATION OF THE SAFER INTERNET DAY PHILIPPINES (SIDPh)

To: Public Schools District Supervisors/ Principals In-Charge Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

1. This has reference to the Joint Memorandum from the office of the Undersecretary for Curriculum and Teaching and Undersecretary for Operations through the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) dated January 8, 2024 regarding the conduct of a classroom-based learning session for the awareness of the Anti-OSAEC and CSAEM policy in schools in partnership with the Stairway Foundation, Inc. (SFI).

2. The activity shall be conducted in compliance with Presidential Proclamation No. 417, **Declaring the Second Tuesday of February of Every Year as Safer Internet Day for Children in the Philippines;** and in line with the promulgation of the Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR) of Republic Act No. 11930 entitled **An Act punishing Online Sexual Abuse or Exploitation of Children, Penalizing the Production, Distribution, Possession and Access of Child Sexual Abuse or Exploitation Material (CSAEM)**.

3. Anent this, there shall have a national orientation to the teachers, educators, nonteaching/support personnel, parents, and stakeholders to be conducted via Facebook live through **DepEd official Facebook Page on February 13, 2024**.

4. The classroom-based session shall be conducted by **classroom advisers** during their Homeroom subject on any day of February in time for the observance of the Safer Internet Day Philippines. 5. For Monitoring and Evaluation, class advisers shall submit a list of attendees of the classroom-based session including the number of reported disclosures, if any, using the template (Refer to the enclosure for Annex A.) to the School Head. The School Head shall consolidate the data (number of attendees per







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grade level) with the assistance of the School's Guidance Counselor/Coordinator or Administrative Personnel in compliance with DepEd Order No. 2, s. 2024 or the **Immediate Removal of Administrative Tasks of Public-School Teachers**, and supply the needed data of the School's Division Office through the following links:
