DIVISION MEMORANDUM SGOD No. 7 5 s. 2024

BASIC TRAINING COURSES FOR KAWAN LEADERS, TROOP LEADERS AND OUTFIT ADVISORS

To: SGOD and CID Chiefs Public Schools District Supervisors/Principals In-Charge Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

1. In line with the noble aspiration of the Schools Division of South Cotabato to commit to demonstrate high level of professionalism by passionately pursuing excellence in providing quality service with advanced innovations in the spirit of respect and teamwork, in collaboration with BSP-South Cotabato Council humbly presents its proposal to conduct a **Three-Day Basic Training Courses for Kawan Leaders, Troop Leaders and Outfit Advisors** at Lake Sebu Central Elementary School and Lake Sebu National High School campuses, Barangay Poblacion, Lake Sebu, South Cotabato on February 16 – 18, 2024.

2. This activity aims to:

a. train leaders on how to organize scout units, their functions and responsibilities;

b. capacitate adult leaders in planning and implementing activities necessary for the effective development of the character of their scouts enabling them to be disciplined and concerned citizens in the scout unit, in the home, in the institution, in the community, and the outdoors; and

c. contribute positive and progressive growth for the personal development of participants through the leadership program of the scout movement.

3. For the **List of Activity Staff**, all personnel concerned are advised to refer to the enclosure to this memorandum.

4. Participants in this training are schoolheads, teachers, lay leaders, or volunteers who have not yet undergone any Basic Training in Scouting, who are physically fit and of good moral character and who must have been partially or fully vaccinated. Pregnant women are advised to defer their desire to join this training for safety reasons.





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5. All participants are further advised to report to the training venue on February 16, 2024, at 8:00 a.m. for briefing, billeting, and organization. The Opening Program will commence at 10:00 am. All training staff are expected to arrive by 4:00 p.m. on February 15, 2024.

6. This is a live-in training. Hence, a training registration fee of One Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (1,600.00) which will be utilized to defray the expenses for food, snacks, certificates, hand-outs, and administrative and other related training expenses shall be collected to participants.

7. Registration Fee shall be remitted to the BSP Local Council Headquarters before the start of the training together with the duly accomplished Application Form to ensure/determine the number of participants. All BSP Coordinators are advised to register their participants in the district on or before February 14, 2024.

8. Travel, training registration, and other incidental expenses of participants are chargeable to the School MOOE or other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures and availability of funds.

9. For services rendered on Saturday and Sunday, all DepEd personnel concerned shall be entitled to service credits/compensatory overtime credit (COC) under the Civil Service and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 after approval of this memorandum by the Schools Division Superintendent.

10. All participants in this training are required to bring sleeping gear, rubber shoes, extra clothes, personal medicines/First Aid Kit, and BSP Type A & B uniform (if any) – The minimum uniform requirement is an adult neckerchief and plain white t-shirt for printing of the BTC logo. Participants who are not currently registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines are required to bring 100.00 for payment and processing of BSP Adult Membership.

11. The participants in this activity are further reminded to strictly observe the existing health protocols such as billeting participants to a maximum of eight (8) persons per classroom, wearing face masks, observing social distancing, and washing and sanitizing hands in the whole course of the training.
