- 4. Since the activity falls on a school day, concerned schools are enjoined to adopt measures to ensure that NO classes of teacher-participants are left unattended. Schools are encouraged to follow schemes such as the distribution of learners to different sections, assigning other teachers or the school head to handle classes, or other strategies most applicable and beneficial to the learners. School heads should closely monitor the implementation of these measures and make sure that classes are not disrupted.
- 5. For services rendered on Holidays, Saturdays, and Sundays, all non teaching personnel concerned are entitled to Compensatory Time Off (CTO) per Civil Service and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.
- 6. Expenses such as meals and snacks allowance, transportation, and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants relative to and during the conduct of the activity shall be charged to local funds (LGU/PTA) and School/Division MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
