# CONDUCT OF POLICY RESEARCH ON THE MATATAG CURRICULUM PILOT IMPLEMENTATION IN SELECT SCHOOLS OF SOCCSKSARGEN

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Divisions of Sarangani and Cotabato

- 1. This has reference to the directive from the office of the Assistant Secretary of Administration, OIC-Planning Service, ASec Noel T. Baluyan through USec Nolasco A. Mempin, Undersecretary for Administration regarding Unnumbered Memorandum, dated February 29, 2024 on "*Prioritization of Research Proposals Related to the Pilot Implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum*." Considering that the allocation of Basic Education Research Fund (BERF) of DepEd 12 has already been allocated for the FY 2024 recipients prior to the issuance of such directive, the PPRD will take charge to initiate policy research of the *MATATAG Curriculum Pilot Implementation* in select schools of SOCCSKSARGEN.
- 2. Basically, this policy research will focus on the implementation of **DepEd Memorandum 54**, s. 2023: Pilot Implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum, wherein DepEd SOSSCSARGEN has the following identified pilot schools: Alegria Central Elementary School, Alegria National High School, Lamlifew Integrated School, San Vicente National High School, and Mlang Pilot Elementary School.
- 3. Apparently, as offshoot of the 4th Quarter Learning Action Cell (LAC) cum Performance Review regarding "Policy, Planning and Research Division 2023 Research Agenda as Mechanism in the Development of Research-Enabled Innovations," wherein based on the evaluation there is a need for PPRD to come-up with a research agenda focused on the pillar on quality. Hence, this additional research undertaking for FY 2024 is hereby proposed: "In-depth Evaluation of MATATAG Curriculum Pilot Implementation in DepEd SOCCSKSARGEN: Innovations, Issues, Interventions."
- 4. Considering that such research agenda is aligned to PPRD's strategic direction for FY 2024 and as part of its responsive mechanism to fully institutionalize data-driven strategies through efficient and effective collaboration with interested parties, partner agencies and learning institutions, it is then being enforced. Such endeavor is also in alignment with PPRD's Quality Management System (QMS) process on Policy Development focusing on policy implementation and review sub-processes. Consequently, the findings of this research undertaking shall be utilized as basis for contextualization of policy recommendation based on the in-depth evaluation of MATATAG curriculum pilot implementation in DepEd SOCCSKSARGEN by capturing the innovations initiated and issues encountered as basis for the formulation of intervention mechanisms so that the **2,534 public and private schools** would be







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provided guidance in the full implementation of **MATATAG Curriculum** particularly in Kindergarten, Grades 1, 4 and 7 in the opening of SY 2024-2025.

- 5. Generally, this policy research study aims to evaluate the pilot implementation of MATATAG Curriculum in DepEd SOCCSKSARGEN vis-à-vis DepEd Memorandum 54, s. 2023.
- 6. Specifically, this study will seek to realize the following research objectives:
  - a. To determine the mean scores of learners of the following schools before the pilot implementation of MATATAG Curriculum: Alegria Central Elementary School, Alegria National High School, Lamlifew Integrated School, Mlang Pilot Elementary School; and San Vicente National High School.
  - b. To determine the mean scores of learners of the following schools after the pilot implementation of MATATAG Curriculum: Alegria Central Elementary School, Alegria National High School, Lamlifew Integrated School, Mlang Pilot Elementary School; and San Vicente National High School.
  - c. To find out if there is significant difference in the mean scores of the following schools before and after the pilot implementation of MATATAG Curriculum: Alegria Central Elementary School, Alegria National High School, Lamlifew Integrated School, Mlang Pilot Elementary School; and San Vicente National High School.
  - d. To find out the level of implementation of MATATAG Curriculum based on teachers, learners and school major stakeholders' (PSDS, school heads and SGC) evaluation towards the following features: Curriculum decongestion, Foundational skills, Balanced cognitive demands, Articulation of 21st century skills, Learning areas reduction, Intensification of Values Education and Peace Education, and Alignment with international standards.
  - e. To ascertain if there is significant difference in the level of implementation of MATATAG Curriculum based on teachers, learners and school major stakeholders' (PSDS, school heads and SGC) evaluation towards the following features: Curriculum decongestion, Foundational skills, Balanced cognitive demands, Articulation of 21st century skills, Learning areas reduction, Intensification of Values Education and Peace Education, and Alignment with international standards.
  - f. To Identify internal and external issues experienced by pilot schools in the implementation of MATATAG Curriculum.
  - g. To find out innovations initiated by school major stakeholders for the effective implementation of MATATAG Curriculum.
  - h. To formulate proposed interventions to further improve the implementation of MATATAG Curriculum based on the results of the study.
