- 1. This has reference to Region Memorandum PPRD-2024-018 regarding "Conduct of Policy Research on the MATATAG Curriculum Pilot Implementation in Select Schools of SOCCSKSARGEN" issued on March 12, 2024 in line with the research titled, "In-depth Evaluation of MATATAG Curriculum Pilot Implementation: Innovations, Issues, Interventions."
- 2. After finalizing the survey questionnaire of this study and subjecting it in content validation process, the "Conduct of Online Survey Questionnaire for the Policy Research on the MATATAG Curriculum Pilot Implementation in Select Schools of SOCCSKSARGEN" is hereby being undertaken.

 - a. To determine the mean scores of learners of the following schools before the pilot implementation of MATATAG Curriculum: Alegria Central Elementary School, Alegria National High School, Lamlifew Integrated School, Mlang Pilot Central Elementary School; and San Vicente National High School.
 - b. To determine the mean scores of learners of the following schools after the pilot implementation of MATATAG Curriculum: Alegria Central Elementary School, Alegria National High School, Lamlifew Integrated School, Mlang Pilot Central Elementary School; and San Vicente National High School.
 - c. To find out if there is significant difference in the mean scores of the following schools before and after the pilot implementation of MATATAG Curriculum: Alegria Central Elementary School, Alegria National High School, Lamlifew Integrated School, Mlang Pilot Central Elementary School; and San Vicente National High School.
 - d. To find out the level of implementation of MATATAG Curriculum based on teachers, learners and school major stakeholders' (PSDS, school heads and SGC) evaluation towards the following features: Curriculum decongestion, Foundational skills, Balanced cognitive demands, Articulation of 21st century







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skills, Intensification of Values Education and Peace Education, Alignment with international standards, and Learning environment.

- e. To ascertain if there is significant difference in the level of implementation of MATATAG Curriculum based on teachers, learners and school major stakeholders' (PSDS, school heads and SGC) evaluation towards the following features: Curriculum decongestion, Foundational skills, Balanced cognitive demands, Articulation of 21st century skills, Intensification of Values Education and Peace Education, Alignment with international standards, and Learning environment.
- f. To find out innovations initiated by school major stakeholders for the effective implementation of MATATAG Curriculum.
- g. To Identify internal and external issues experienced by pilot schools in the implementation of MATATAG Curriculum.
- h. To formulate proposed interventions to further improve the implementation of MATATAG Curriculum based on the results of the study.
