To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. With reference to Memorandum DM-CT-2024-155 from the Office of the Undersecretary for Curriculum and Teaching, the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) in coordination with the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) will conduct a **“Workshop on the Conformance Review of the Validated Accreditation & Equivalency (A&E) Program Curriculum Guides”** on June 3-5, 2024 in a venue at the National Capital Region (NCR), which will be announced in a separate issuance.
