REQUEST ON THE CONSOLIDATED REPORTS OF LEARNER RIGHTS AND PROTECTION CASES FOR SY 2023-2024

To: Schools Division Superintendents School Heads/Principals, Public and Private Schools All Others Concerned

1. This has reference to the unnumbered Memorandum dated June 8, 2023 from the Office of the Undersecretary for Operations, requesting for the **submission of the consolidated reports** on incidence on bullying and Child-abuse, as well as cases involving children-at-risk (CAR) and children in conflict with the law (CICL) and other learner rights and protection cases and concerns.

2. Likewise, being requested is the submission of number of schools with localized child protection policies, anti-bullying policies and schools with established child protection committees (CPC's).

Note: Child Abuse refers to the maltreatment of a child, whether habitual or not, which includes any of the following:

Physical - refers to acts that inflict bodily harm and which subjects children to perform tasks which are hazardous to their physical well-being.

Sexual - refer to acts that are sexual in nature such as rape, sexual harassment, sexually demeaning remarks, forcing children to watch obscene publications or shows, etc; and

Psychological - refers to acts or omissions causing or likely to cause mental or emotional suffering to the child which include intimidation harassment, stalking, public ridicule, threat of deduction from grade or merit as a form of punishment, and repeated verbal abuse.

Relationship to the victim refers to relatives (father, mother, cousin, etc.) or School Personnel (teachers and non-teaching staff)
