

This event is aimed at enhancing to a higher level the leadership capabilities of Langkay Leaders and Kawan Leaders as they will pass through the five (5) sectional activities that will equip them of necessary skills in handling our KID and KAB Scouts, hence, it is highly encouraged that each District to send a minimum of 5 Adult Leaders, to have a proper representation on the five (5) sectional activities, to wit:

- b. KAB Sulong (Advancement)
